

RECOMMENDED SCHEDULE FOR ALL BUS FINANCE MAJORS¹

If you entered UIUC before Fall 2006, your REQUIRED courses are unchanged. The Finance department RECOMMENDS, however, that you consider following the revised requirements; that is, we recommend that you take an additional three hours of Finance, and that you take at least nine hours of advanced Finance courses (311, 321, or 4xx). We also recommend additional hours of Accountancy beyond Accy 201 and 202.
