OCT 17 DEADLINES | Deadline to drop an Undergraduate semester (16-week) course without grade of W. Use UI-Integrate to DROP course(s) from your schedule.

Deadline to remove Undergraduate Incomplete grade from previous semester to prevent change to an F grade.

Deadline to change grade mode of an Undergraduate semester (16-week) course:

- Elect Credit/No Credit OR
- Change a Credit/No Credit course to regular grade mode.

Use STARS to submit your change grade mode request.

Deadline for Undergraduate student to completely WITHDRAW from the semester without grade of W. Contact the Business Undergraduate Affairs Office to withdraw from all classes.
