Each day has a different set of employers in attendance, so plan to attend whenever you're available on both days. The fair is open to all majors and grade levels – just remember to bring your I-Card, extra copies of your resumes and dress professionally.

The Winter Business Career Fair is an excellent opportunity to highlight your strengths in person and allows recruiters to put a face with a name. Recruiters meet hundreds of students per day so come prepared with a short introduction that tells the recruiter your past experiences, whether they were at work, in a school organization, or volunteering.
